

8 Covenants God Made with Mankind

1. The Covenant of Eden
 - Genesis 1:26-31; 2:16-17
 - This was the first covenant between God and man, and it was a conditional covenant. Adam and Eve did not obey the commands of God, and their unfaithfulness was the downfall of mankind.
2. Adam's Covenant
 - Genesis 3:14-19
 - This covenant was an unconditional covenant. The covenant God made with Adam promised a redeemer would come one day and restore man from the fall.
3. Noah's Covenant
 - Genesis 8:20-9:27
 - The covenant with Noah was an everlasting, unconditional covenant. The Lord promised to never destroy creation with a flood again.
4. Abraham's Covenant
 - Genesis 12:1-4, 13:14-17, 15:1-7, 17:1-5
 - The covenant between Abraham and God is unconditional because he promised Abraham's descendents would be a great nation, and there would be a redeemer through the covenant.
5. Moses' Covenant
 - Exodus 20:1-31:18
 - The covenant with Moses is a conditional one. God set up laws for his people to follow so they could become a great nation and the Redeemer could come.
6. Israel's Covenant
 - Deuteronomy 30:1-20
 - The covenant God made with Israel is an unconditional one. The people of Israel will always be God's chosen people. They are the nation He chose the redeemer to come through (Jesus, the Son of God).
7. David's Covenant
 - II Samuel 7:14-16

- The covenant God made with David is unconditional.
8. The New Covenant
- Jeremiah 31:31-33
 - Hebrews 8:7-13
 - The New Covenant is an unconditional one. It is the fulfillment of all God promised us through the sacrifice of Jesus. The new Covenant is for Jews and Gentiles alike.
