

## **MIND OF CHRIST**

*The mind of natural man before accepting Jesus and His changes in our lives.*

**AS THE DAYS OF MOSES, THE MIND IS STILL BLINDED**      **2 Corinthians 3:14-16 (12-18)**

- But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ. But even this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on the heart. Never the less, when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.

**HOSTILE**      **Colossians 1:21 (19-23)**

- And you who once were alienated and enemies *in your mind* by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled.

**DEBASED OF MIND (Sinful Mind)**      **Romans 1:21 (21-31)**

- For although they knew God, they neither glorified Him as God nor gave thanks to Him, but their thinking became futile and their hearts were darkened. Although they claim to be wise, they become fool...

**CORRUPT MINDS**      **Titus 1:15-16**

- To the pure, all things are pure, but those who are corrupted and do not believe, nothing is pure. In fact, both their minds and consciences are corrupted. They claim to know God, but their actions, they deny Him.

**THE RENEWED MIND**      **Romans 12:2**

- Do not conform any longer to the patterns of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is. His good, pleasing, and perfect will.

**THE WILLING MIND**      **1 Chronicles 28:9**

- And you my son (Solomon) acknowledge the God of your father, and serve Him with wholehearted devotion and with a willing mind, for the Lord searches every heart and understands every motive behind the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will reject you forever.

**COVENANT OF GOD**      **Hebrews 8:10**

- I will put my laws in their minds and write them on their hearts.

**CONTROLLED MIND**      **Romans 8:6**

- The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace.

### **PHILIPPIANS 2:5-8**

5 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus:

6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped,

7 but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death— even death on a cross!

9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,

10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
